


Global gas market development: incremental demand will be concentrated in the non-OECD countries






Unconventional gas is becoming increasingly important, but major incremental supply will come from the new conventional field development in the traditional producing regions


Growth of gas production by region in 2010–40



Gas production by type




Russian gas production potential is huge, significantly exceeding domestic demand

European gas market is not recovering, but existing long-term contracts guarantee stable sales volumes for Russia until at least 2022


